This high level conference is jointly organised by the German Federal Ministry of Economics and Technology and the OECD. 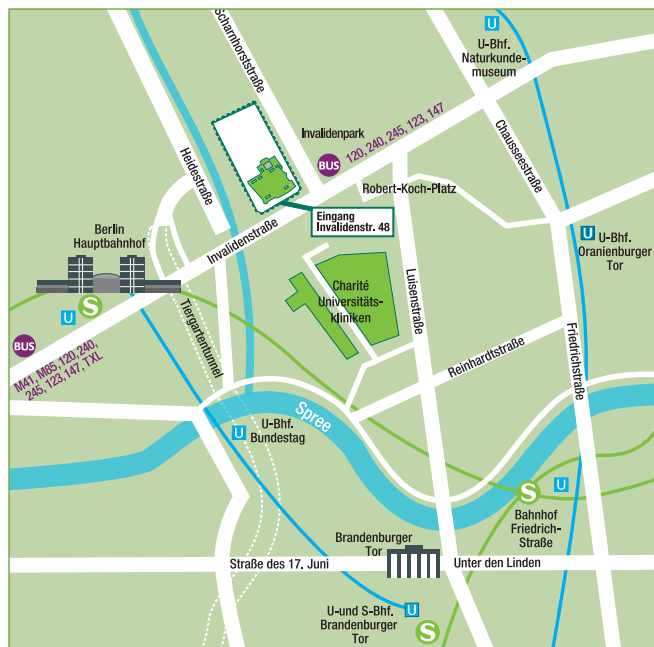
