

Quantifying and Qualifying the Benefits of R&I Cooperation with China. Tangible Benefits for Europe from R&I Collaboration with China

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While R&I cooperation with China poses clear challenges to the EU, it also holds many opportunities. Considering the lack of understanding of contemporary China, its academic system and goals, it is important that the EU does not miss out on these potential benefits and identifies potential opportunities in cooperating with China.
