They engage with and support ECSA members and non-members through a wide range of activities, which they promote through ECSA's working groups and participation in several Horizon 2020 (H2020) projects. ECSA also participates in the EU-Citizen. Science consortium, an online platform for sharing knowledge, tools, training and resources for citizen science that was launched in 2020.
